### 1. Election for Centenier

Mr Harrison invited nominations for the role of Centenier

Mrs Moody informed the Assembly as Church Almoner, she had worked with Centenier Woodall during his time as Sexton for the Parish Church. There being no further nominations, Mr Harrison declared Mr Jonathan Mark Woodall to be elected as Centenier for the Parish of St Lawrence. Mr Harrison thanked Mr Woodall for re-standing for the position and for his 7 years' service in the Honorary Police. Mr Harrison invited Centenier Elect Woodall to address the Assembly, when he thanked his Proposer, Mrs Moody and his Seconders.
