In accordance with Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law, A Parish of St Lawrence nomination meeting will be held at St Lawrence Parish Hall on Wednesday 31 July 2024 at 7pm to elect a Procureur for a 3-year term of office.

All electors are welcome to attend.

A nomination for each candidate must be produced to the meeting and must be completed by a proposer and 9 seconders who are electors in the Parish.

In each election if there are:

- more candidates than vacancies a poll will be held on Wednesday 11 September 2024
- not more candidates than vacancies any duly nominated candidate will be declared elected at the nomination meeting

To vote in this election you must be registered by midday on the day before the nomination meeting

**1. Election for Procureur du Bien Public**

The Connétable invited nominations for the role of Procureur du Bien Public.

Mr Martin Sabey addressed the Assembly; he said that he had pleasure in proposing Mr Bruce Derek Harrison, for the role of Procureur du Bien Public. He informed the Assembly that he had worked with Mr Harrison for over 20 years as Rates Assessor's and Procureur and found him to be kind and compassionate.

Mr Sabey read the full Nomination form, the names of all signatories having already been
