Centenier nomination meeting

A nomination form for each candidate for election must be produced to the meeting and must be completed by a proposer and 9 seconders who are electors in the parish.

In each election:

- if there are more candidates than vacancies, a poll will be held on **Wednesday 23rd July 2025**
- if there are not more candidates than vacancies, any duly nominated candidate will be declared elected at the nomination meeting

To vote in this election you must have registered by midday on Monday 23rd June 2025.

1. Election for Centenier

The Connétable invited nominations for the role of Centenier.

There being no further nominations, the Connétable declared Mrs Alexandra Winston duly elected as Centenier for the Parish of St Lawrence. The Connétable informed Centenier-Elect Winston that she was waiting to receive her vetting check from the Vetting Unit.
